Become a member and support the EGPHA's efforts to ensure local clinicians represent the interests of our local communities.

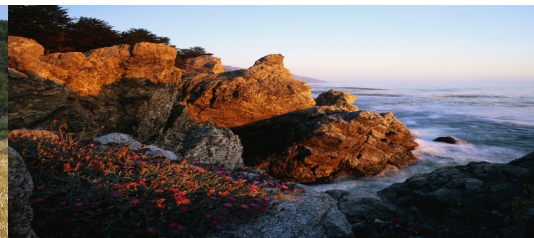
Membership Benefits

The **East Gippsland Primary Health Alliance** supports GP Practices, Primary Health services and providers across the region by:

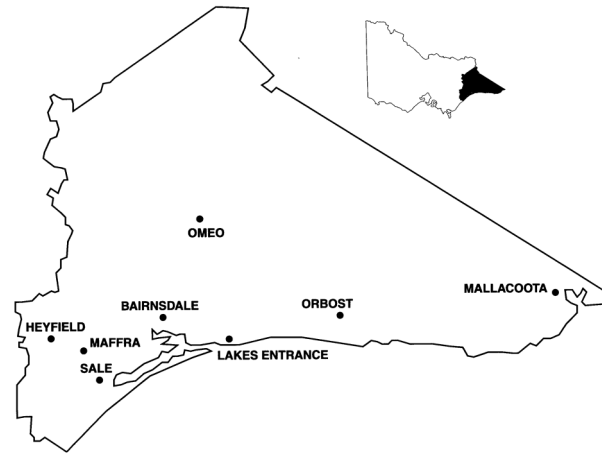
- Supporting General Practitioners, Primary Health providers, and their staff in a changing environment
